Dear Families

As part of our commitment to the community, we are dedicated to ensuring as many young men as possible have access to a Hereworth education and are proud to offer the 2018 scholarships. These scholarships are based in a number of key areas as itemised in the attached notices.

All current and new boys contemplating entering the Year 6 and 7 levels will be expected to take an entrance test.

The Entrance and Academic Scholarship tests are the same.

This testing is also to help place boys in classes to best suit their learning needs. The tests will get progressively harder with no boy being expected to answer all questions correctly. Boys who gain the top results will be considered for Academic Scholarships.

In the case of applicants coming in for the entrance testing morning, where home is some distance away, boys are welcome to come to school at 5pm on the Wednesday afternoon and stay in the Boarding House overnight. (This of course is optional.)

Testing

Entrance/Academic

Testing will take place on the *morning* of Thursday 3 August starting at 8.30 am and will be finished by lunchtime.

Performing Arts Scholarship (if applicable)

Testing will take place on the *afternoon* of Thursday 3 August starting at 1.00pm; an individual appointment time will be arranged and advised by return.

Parents of boys undergoing entrance testing are warmly invited to join with other prospective parents and staff to share a casual lunch at 12.00 noon in the Founders' Room. Your son is also welcome to join the rest of the school for lunch in the Dining Room. If boys do not stay for lunch they will be at the front of school for collection by 12.00 noon, otherwise it is a 12.30 pm pickup after their lunch, and/or yours.

Criteria for all scholarships are enclosed. **Please read these criteria carefully before applying.**

Scholarships at Hereworth - 2018

The Opportunity of a Lifetime



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As one of the leading boys' independent preparatory schools in New Zealand, Hereworth offers an environment where hard work, honesty, integrity, good character and excellence are encouraged. We are aware that many boys would thrive in the Hereworth environment, but in some cases, the financial commitment for their families is a barrier.

Hereworth is committed to being accessible, giving opportunities to boys with great character, who will positively contribute to our school culture.

Boys who take up the opportunity of a scholarship, need to understand that such an opportunity brings responsibilities - to Hereworth, their families and themselves. Scholarship recipients share their talents, encourage others around them and demonstrate that they will contribute positively to society beyond Hereworth.

Criteria

Hereworth offers a range of scholarships and bursaries for boys entering Years 6 and 7.

Academic and Performing Arts Scholarships are awarded on merit.

Recipients of all other scholarships and bursaries at Hereworth must satisfy the following criteria:

- for financial reasons, the applicant would not attend Hereworth without the aid of a scholarship
- the family and the individual boy need to demonstrate a genuine commitment to wanting their son to attend Hereworth, and who are faithful to the school's values
- the applicant is a good role model for others and will be a good Hereworth citizen, both in school and the wider community

Families can apply for more than one scholarship; however, they are only eligible to receive one.

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Academic Scholarship

The academic scholarship is awarded to boys in Year 5 (at either Hereworth or another school) at the time of the entrance testing examination.

This is a three year scholarship to the value of 50% of tuition fees awarded to a boy on his performance in the entrance examinations that test literacy and numeracy. To retain the scholarship, academic performance must be maintained at a consistently high level in all curriculum areas for the duration of his scholarship.

This scholarship is open to current and new students.

Performing Arts Scholarship

The scholarship is awarded to boys in Year 5 (at either Hereworth or another school) at the time of auditions.

This is a three year scholarship to the value of 50% of tuition fees awarded to a boy who demonstrates the most promising choral, musical, dance or acting ability.

Applicants are asked to prepare an audition piece of their choice to be performed for the Director of Performing Arts. Further details can be found on the application form for the Performing Arts Scholarship.

This scholarship is open to current and new students.

In order to apply for these scholarships, a pre-enrolment form must be completed and all applicants will have, or have had, an interview with the Headmaster.

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Academic Scholarship

The Academic Scholarship is awarded to boys in Year 6 (at either Hereworth or another school) at the time of the entrance testing examination.

This is a two-year scholarship to the value of 50% of tuition fees awarded to a boy on his performance in the entrance examinations that test literacy and numeracy. To retain the scholarship, the boy must maintain a top 10 class placing within the top academic class for the duration of his scholarship.

This scholarship is open to current and new students.

Performing Arts Scholarship

The Performing Arts Scholarship is awarded to boys in Year 6 (at either Hereworth or another school) at the time of auditions.

This is a two year scholarship to the value of 50% of tuition fees awarded to a boy who demonstrates the most promising choral, musical, dance, speech or drama ability. Applicants are asked to prepare an audition piece of their choice to be performed for the Director of Performing Arts. Further details can be found on the application form for the Performing Arts Scholarship.

This scholarship is open to current and new students.

Hereworth Old Boys' Scholarship

The Old Boys Scholarship is awarded to a boy who, in the opinion of the Old Boys' Scholarship Committee, will benefit most from the opportunity of attending Hereworth. On completion of his time at Hereworth the scholarship awardee will do his utmost to maintain the Hereworth values and traditions and be proud to be a Hereworth Old Boy.

The scholarship covers 50% of the tuition and/or boarding (if required) fees of a boy starting Hereworth in Year 7 and is tenable for two years.

Headmaster's Boarding Scholarship for Excellence

The Headmaster's Boarding Scholarship is awarded to a boy who demonstrates excellence in his field, whether that be academic, cultural or in sport.

This is a two year scholarship to the value of 30% of tuition and boarding fees.

Headmaster's Dayboy Scholarship for Excellence

The Headmaster's Dayboy Scholarship is awarded to a boy who demonstrates excellence in his field, whether that be academic, cultural or in sport.

This is a two year scholarship to the value of 30% of tuition fees.

Headmaster's All Round Scholarship

The Headmaster's All Round Scholarship is awarded to a boy who demonstrates a commitment to learning across the cornerstones of Hereworth: academic, cultural, spiritual and sport.

This is a two year scholarship to the value of 30% of tuition fees.

Headmaster's Scholarship for Values

The Headmaster's Scholarship for Values is awarded to the boy who demonstrates a commitment to Hereworth's values: caring, committed, pro-active, principled and time-honoured.

This is a two year scholarship to the value of 30% of tuition fees.

In order to apply for these scholarships, applicants must have had, or be scheduled to have, an enrolment interview with the Headmaster.

Headmaster's Bursaries

A limited number of bursaries are also available each year to families new to Hereworth who, without financial assistance, would not be able to enrol their son.

Bursaries are awarded confidentially on a case by case basis. All discussions concerning funding are between the Headmaster and the family and as financial need is a pre-requisite for bursaries, evidence of need may be requested.
