### **Hereworth Camps**

At Hereworth we strive to give our boys opportunities to develop their physical, social, emotional and spiritual well-being (Hauora) both inside and outside the classroom. The camps from Years 5-8 will be both exciting and challenging learning experiences for the boys. Camp programmes will be run by qualified professionals who will be dedicated to meeting our educational and safety requirements.

The camps are a progression to build on previous experiences and to provide a quality and safe Education Outside the Classroom (EOTC) experience for the boys. Please see details below of your son's camp.

### **Camp Summary**

- Year 4/5: Guthrie Smith Centre Tutira, February 5-7 Term 1 2018  
Approximate cost \$150 - 180
- Year 6: Guthrie Smith Centre Tutira, February 7-9 Term 1 2018  
Approximate cost \$200 - 250
- Year 7: Makahika Outdoor Pursuits Centre, February 5-9 Term 1 2018  
Approximate cost \$440 - 460
- Year 8: Hillary Outdoors Education Centre Tongariro, February 6-9 Term 1 2018  
Approximate cost \$500 - 550

The cost of the camps for Years 6, 7 and 8 will be charged to your account in two or three instalments from January to March 2018. (The outdoor centres have cancellation clauses and will charge if less than 30-days notice is given for a cancelled place or no show - therefore a \$150 non-refundable deposit is payable.)

Please note: The camps are all in the second week of Term one 2017 and the Year 8 camp will depart at 9.30am on the morning of Waitangi Day.

Team leaders and classroom teachers will communicate with you prior to your son's camp. A small amount of parent assistance will be required. If you are able to assist please contact the school office. Gear lists and medical forms are available on the Hereworth School website, go to 'Community' then 'Parent Portal' and scroll down to camps. Medical forms need to be returned within the first week of term, by Wednesday 31 January.
